



tgi and Co-Lab: current pilots



Currently, we have 6 pilots in early stage development in the North West region where our software 'tools' will be used to provide interactive on-line networks while generating and recycling our L-ocal currency. Sectors are involved include:

- public – government body, local authority, health services, educational and training services
 - 3rd. - charities, social enterprises and co-ops, voluntary and community groups, tenants associations, registered social landlords, faith groups, sports organisations
 - private – local suppliers of goods and services
1. Gorton Monastery - Institute for Well-Being Research - linking communities in Manchester, Salford, Oldham and Sefton to develop new approaches to well-being, inclusion, learning, debt relief, skills exchange, healthy living and related impact studies
 2. A Regional Health Care Trust – training and supporting volunteers and health service clients
 3. A Restorative Justice specialist – introducing restorative practices to organisations, volunteers and front line workers to reduce conflict, disputes, anti-social behaviour, bullying, crime and re-offending
 4. A local Community Trust - a range of community projects to relieve poverty, promote education, strengthen families, develop well-being and wholeness across entire communities
 5. A local Social Enterprise Group - delivering social, leisure, housing, educational and training across an entire community on Merseyside
 6. The Life Story Network – a local CIC working with care providers, carers, housing associations, schools and advocacy groups to deliver improvements to the quality of care and support received by people marginalised through ill-health or social circumstance
